Payment Policy:

One week's tuition is due at time of enrollment. We will apply the deposit to the final week of camp. Weekly camp fees are due every Monday morning at drop-off. We will charge a \$25 late fee if payment is not received by 12 pm Tuesday. Field trips will incur varying additional fees.

Cancelation Policy:

If you enroll in camp and your plans change, you can receive a full refund/credit for camp tuition, less registration fee. **Program change request must be received 2 weeks prior to enrolled camp week start date.** Participants who do not attend their registered camp week, or who do not contact us to cancel two weeks prior to start date, will not receive a refund or credit. By submitting your payment, you are agreeing to the policy outlined above.


