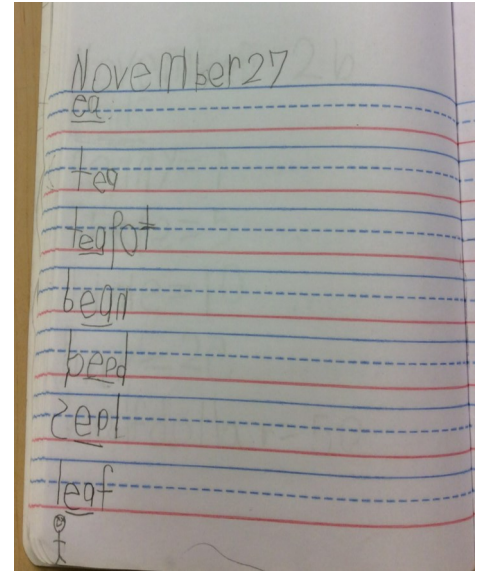
### Geography:
