

JANUARY NEWSLETTER ROOM 2

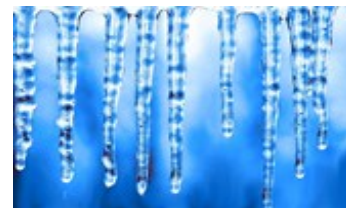
Thank you for a wonderful sing-a-long! I hope you all enjoyed it as much as I did!
