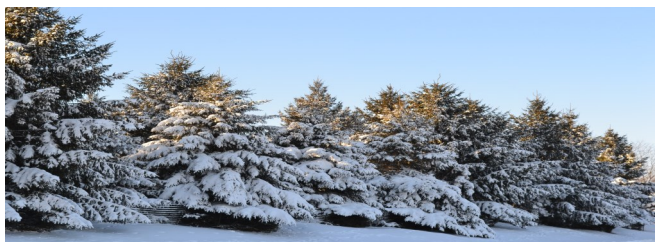


DECEMBER 2019 NEWSLETTER
