JANUARY NEWSLETTER ROOM 2

Happy New Year and welcome back! I hope each of you enjoyed the holiday season, and were able to spend time with family and friends. Though for many Winter Break does not seem long enough, but I am energized and ready to get back into routine.



In geography we will start to learn about the Artic landscape. We will focus on icebergs, glaciers, and snowy mountains. Our continent studies will take us to the Artic this month. We will look at and learn about the different animals that inhabit the land and animals that hibernate, migrate, or adapt.

The children will also learn how to shred and whisk soap, practice with the zipper frame, button frame, and lots of scooping/spooning to develop those fine motor skills. We will continue to learn about primary colors and how to mix them to make the secondary colors.

Our language focus will center around basic literacy skills such as reading left to right, re-telling our stories, matching, and learning our fingerplays. In Math we will build to numeral recognition 1-10 as well as counting, simple patterns, and three of our geometric solids—sphere, cone, and cube.
