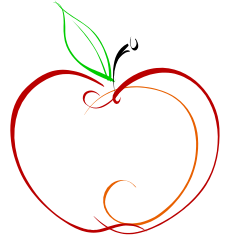

Dear Families,

I am excited to see all of our new and returning friends to the class! The start of the school year is always a chaotic time due to the fact that everyone is trying to get back to their normal routines after summer. Please remember to be patient and to plan for extra time in the morning so your child does not feel rushed to get to school.

Our work period begins at 9:00 am. I will start the morning group promptly at this time. Please have your child to school between 8:45 and 8:55 so that they have plenty of time to put their things away, change their shoes and wash their hands.

During the first few weeks we will concentrate on building our community by learning how to be respectful, how to work together, and how to use an iPad; incase we have to move to a hybrid/ distance learning program.

As you know, this school year is gong to be a little different. Your child will need their own small snack for the morning, as we will not be providing any food this year. You can pack this in their lunchbox. Please also bring a water bottle that can fit or connect with their lunchbox.

Your child will also need a face mask to wear throughout the day. They will not be worn during lunch, recess or nap times.
