The earlier children can learn a sense of responsibility the better. When communicating to children about responsibility, it is very important to make clear intensions and expectations. Make sure to use words that are familiar to children and use more positives than negatives. Focus on the thought process of decision making and learn to see the consequences of the situation before students make choices.
