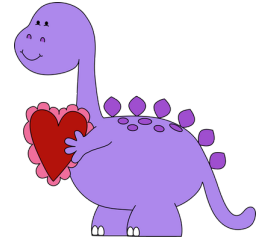


FEBRUARY NEWSLETTER ROOM 9
