With Spring fast approaching, we will start studying the seasons, their weather and the months that make up each season. We will also learn about graphing by graphing our favorite types of weather.

This month our continent focus will be on Antarctica. We will look at Antarctica's biome map and discuss how the size of Antarctica changes during the seasons. We will also learn about the different types of animals that inhabit this icy continent.

Our geography lessons this month will focus on the land forms peninsula and gulf. We will work with the forms and search for these landforms on maps.

In our animal classification studies we will focus on the bird family. We will identify the different body parts, learn about their life cycle and look at pictures of different types of nests and eggs.
